
Application for Parent PLUS Loan (completed each year)

New Borrowers: Complete the Application FIRST, followed by the Master Promissory Note.




Parent Borrower:

Go to https://studentaid.gov/

LOG IN using your **Federal Student Aid ID (FSAID)**. This is the same FSAID you used to sign the FAFSA.

AFTER you sign in:

- 1. Go to the **Loans and Grants** menu at the top of the page.
- 2. Select PLUS Loans: Grad PLUS and Parent PLUS.
- 3. Select a borrower type (I am a Parent of a Student), then click the **START** button
 - Complete all parts of the application.
 - The application includes information about deferring the loan and when payment will start.
 - You can indicate whether you want any credit balance, after OSU charges have been paid, sent to you or to your student. You will receive the results of the credit check once you complete the application.
- Select OSU in Stillwater as the school to receive your Parent PLUS Loan Application information.
- New Borrowers: You must also complete the Master Promissory Note (MPN) the first time you borrow in this program. Instructions are on the next page.








Master Promissory Note (MPN) for Parent PLUS Loan
