## Maximize your scholarship opportunities

Your application for admission is also your application for scholarships, but you could qualify for additional scholarships with these items:

- Official ACT or SAT test score(s)
- Completed essay response
- Leadership and involvement resume (honors, employment, activities, etc.)

The Early Opportunity Scholarship Deadline is Nov. 1, while all scholarship materials must be submitted by Feb. 1 to ensure scholarship consideration for most awards for fall-entering students. For more information on how to complete your file, visit admissions.okstate.edu/scholarship-file.



#### **COMPREHENSIVE REVIEW**

At Oklahoma State University, ALL **STUDENTS** are encouraged to apply because we individually review each application for our holistic and alternative admission programs. We consider many factors, including high school GPA, ACT or SAT scores, application essay response, academic letters of recommendation, leadership experience, community involvement and accomplishments.

#### **ASSURED ADMISSION**

Students qualify for assured admission if they meet **ONE** of the

- 3.0 unweighted cumulative GPA or higher **AND** top 33.3% rank in high school graduating class, **OR**
- 3.0 GPA or better in 15-unit core AND 21 ACT/1060 SAT or higher, OR
- 24 ACT/1160 SAT or higher.

OSU will accept the official superscore provided by ACT for both admission and scholarship consideration. Some majors may have additional requirements, visit **okla.st/program-admission** for more information.

#### **TEST OPTIONAL**

Students have the option to apply to OSU without consideration of a test score. Students who select this option on the application will be considered for admission based on a full review of their high school transcript. Class rank is not required for test optional admission. This also applies to home school, private, parochial or other nonpublic high schools that are not accredited by a recognized accrediting agency.

> Currently, consideration for most university scholarships requires an official test score from ACT or SAT, and we encourage students to provide us their test scores as soon as they are available for maximum scholarship consideration.
