English-language proficiency exams TOEFL iBT Score: 61+ **AND** IELTS Score: 5.5+ **AND** High School GPA: 3.0+ (based on a 4.0 scale)

7-23 credit hours	Freshman admission requirements and 2.25 GPA
24-59 credit hours	2.25 GPA
More than 60 hours or associate degree	2.0 GPA


