United States Citizenship and Immigration Service (USCIS) regulations require documentation that sufficient financial resources are available to meet a student's prospective educational and living expenses while in the U.S. Therefore, Oklahoma State University requires a guarantee of financial resources from each applicant who expects to obtain or maintain Student (F-1) status. Applicants are required to submit financial documentation that equals or exceeds one full academic year of expenses, for the program of study they are interested in pursuing. Adjustments in the financial certification cannot be made based on a student's individual circumstances. This estimate is based upon 15 semester hours each semester for undergraduate studies.

This completed form, as well as a bank statement can be submitted by email at <a href="international@okstate.edu">international@okstate.edu</a>. Students will not be admitted to Oklahoma State University or receive an OSU Certificate of Eligibility (I-20) until this information is provided and verified.

Scholarships are available to international students who meet OSU scholarship criteria, but students should not rely on scholarship funds to finance their educational costs. Visit okla.st/IntlScholarship for more information regarding scholarship opportunities available at OSU.

The amounts listed below are estimates that are determined by using the cost figures for 2021-2022. The costs are subject to change without notice. Historically, total costs have increased on an average of 5-10% each year.
