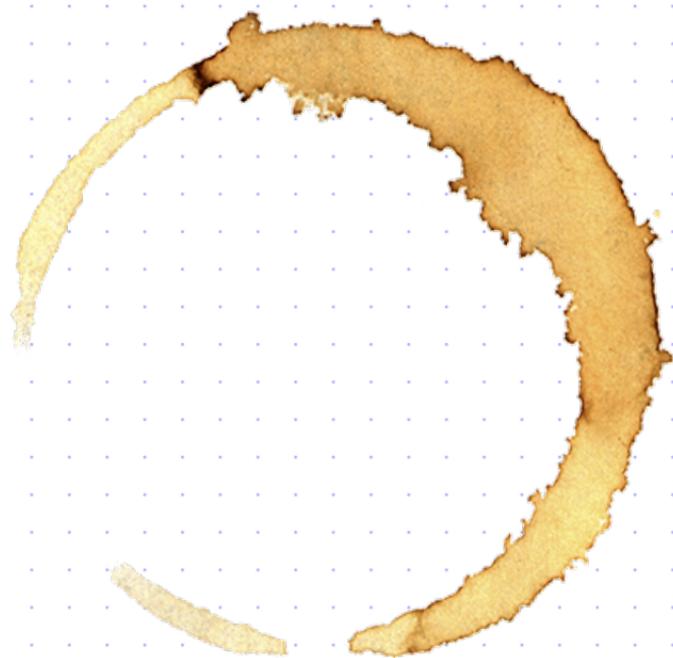

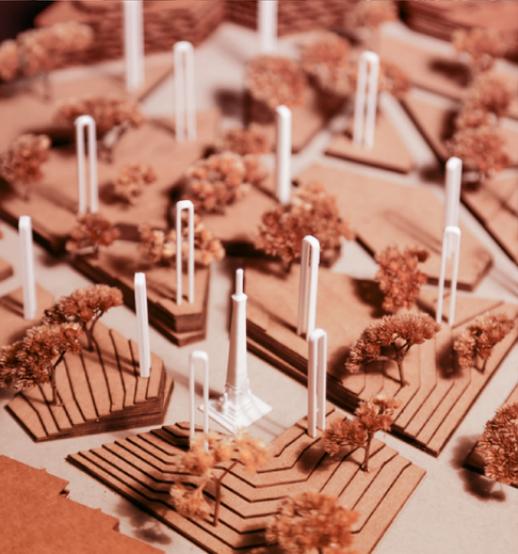
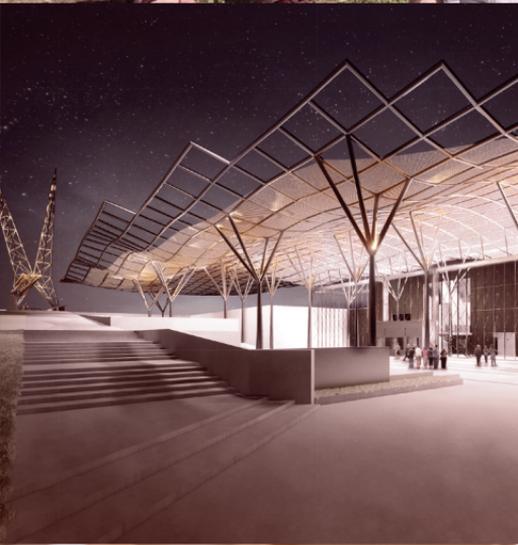

Transform the coffee ring into a sketch.



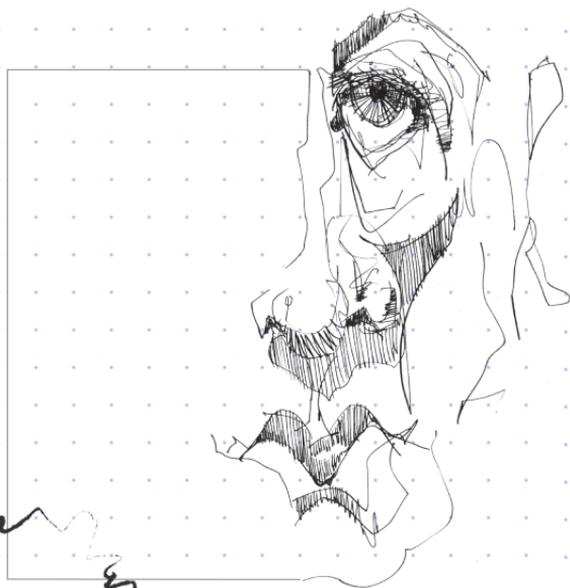

Try sketching a friend without taking your pen off the page.

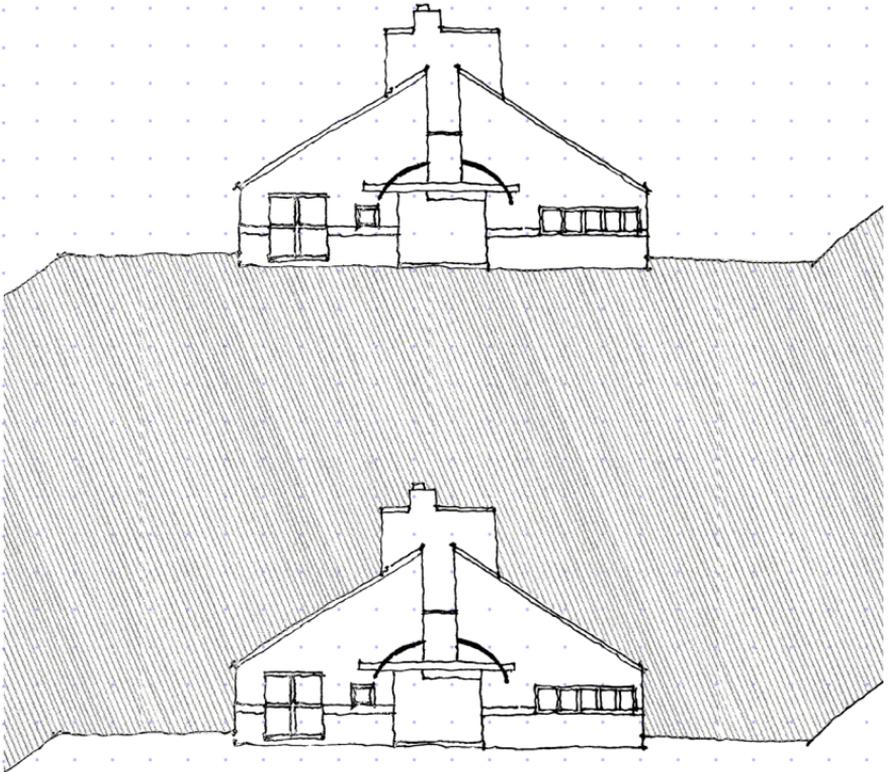
